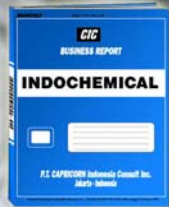

Could the financial crisis and the debt of the United States and several countries in European region can be more severe than the ones in the last 2008?

Asian Development Bank (ADB) has revised the projection of Asia's economic growth in 2011 from the previous 7.8 percent to 7.5 percent and for the year 2012, from 7.7 percent to 7.5 percent, China for the year 2011 of 9, 6 percent to 9.3 percent, South Korea is projected at 4.6 percent slowing to 4.3 percent and Vietnam from 6.1 percent to 5.8 percent. This is the negative impact of financial crisis and debt crisis in the United States and several countries in the European region.

The increase in prices of some commodities may be a threat to Asian countries because it could potentially triggering inflation from original estimation of around 5.3 percent to 5.8 percent.
