**I**NDONESIA still has a high potential in development by investment in its oil palm plantations and palm oil processing plants, because the country does not only has the enough land suitable for the cultivation of oil palm estates, the palm oil export market is also still wide open. Therefore interest in investment in this sector has never declined, even during an economic crisis.

The price of crude palm oil (CPO) had been constantly increasing in the past few years. While in May 2007 the price of the commodity stood at US\$ 700 per ton, one year later the price reached US\$ 1,000 per ton. In view of the current high world CPO consumption and price, oil palm plantation companies have taken various steps. Many of them had expanded their oil palm plantations until 2007. PT. Bakrie Sumatera Plantation Tbk is projecting to develop 200,000 hectares of oil palm estates, assuming that world and Indonesia’s CPO consumption will constantly increase, while CPO is not only used for food, but also as raw material in the production of biofuel


